Timeline

2011: 10,000 +/-	October: Temporary Protected Status
2012: 250,000	October: 100,000 “ceiling” passed
2013: 585,000	Legal protection DGMM / Syrians leave Temporary Accommodation Centers
2014: 1,560,000	
2015: 2,500,000	FRIT and EU support
2016: 2,825,000	Emergency Social Safety Net
2017: 3,425,000	Syrian Doctors in Turkish hospitals
2022: 3,700,000	98% of registered Syrians in Turkey or Syria

Innovative Response

- Facility for Refugees in Turkey (FRiT)
 - Broad and deep support across the society
- Emergency Social Safety Net
 - Direct Cash payments support Syrian families
 - Cash enables choice which restores dignity
- Syrians under Temporary Protection (SuTP)
 - 98% of Syrians remain in Turkey or returned to Syria
